

SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Mulberry is applying to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a grant under the Neighborhood Revitalization category in the amount of \$700,000.00 under the FFY 2018 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. For each activity that is proposed, at least 70% of the funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The activities, dollar amounts and estimated percentage benefit to low and moderate income persons for which the City of Mulberry is applying are:

Service Area #1 Lift Station #6 Replacement Service Area:

Sewer Line Replacement - The existing sanitary sewer lift station located at the intersection of 8th Avenue NW and 5th Street NW will be relocated and replaced. Lift station #6 is failing and beyond its useful life and in need of replacement. The scope of the project is to relocate and replace pumping station #6 with a new modern pumping station. The new pumping station will be constructed on City owned property located approximately 325 feet north of the existing pumping station. A new gravity sewer main approximately 325 linear feet with manholes will be constructed to re-route sewage flow to allow the pumping station to be relocated. A new 4” force main approximately 325 linear feet will be constructed. The raw sewage effluent from all of the homes in Service Area #1 will flow through the new replacement lift station. The activity proposed in Service Area #1 involves the full relocation and replacement of the existing Lift Station including a new valve vault, concrete top, new electrical service, a new pump control panel, new pumps, rails, lifting chair and cables, new water service and a new instrument panel.

A final copy of the application will be made available at City of Mulberry City Hall, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. no more than five (5) working days after May 6, 2019. The application will be submitted to DEO on or before the application due date May 6, 2019.
