A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MULBERRY OF POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Executive Order 19-190 dated August 29, 2019, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has declared a State of Emergency in Polk County, Florida due to the approach of Hurricane Dorian, a Category 5 tropical cyclone; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mulberry of Polk County, Florida scheduled a public hearing to adopt a tentative millage rate for the levying of ad valorem taxes and a tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 for September 5, 2019 at 5:30 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order 19-189 dated August 28, 2019, Executive Order 19-190 and Florida Department of Revenue Emergency Order 19-001 dated September 3, 2019, the City of Mulberry of Polk County, Florida has rescheduled its public hearing to adopt a tentative millage rate for the levying of ad valorem taxes and a tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to September 10, 2019 at 5:30 P.M., and has complied with all modified public notice requirements announced in the Executive Orders and Emergency Order; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mulberry of Polk County, Florida on September 10, 2019, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Polk County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Mulberry of Polk County, Florida as \$214,953,753;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Mulberry of Polk County, Florida that:

1. The Fiscal Year 2019-2020 operating millage rate is 6.4400 mils, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 6.3427 mils by 1.53%.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
