During Fiscal Year 2021-2022, the Mulberry CRA engaged in three redevelopment projects. First, the CRA began a renovation and building stabilization project for a planned eatery and retail location (the "Depot"), Second, the CRA completed the Gem Theatre renovation and building stabilization project. The City also awarded an impact fee assistance grant during the year. Both projects are considered "Redevelopment Catalyst Projects" under the *Mulberry Community Redevelopment Area – Master Plan 2015*.
